Hattie B. Gage

Hattie B. (Robinson) Gage was born 27 May 1868 in Yarmouth¹, the daughter of Jeremiah Robinson and Dama (Gage) Robinson. She died 7 Nov 1931 in Yarmouth² at age 63 and is buried in Ancient Cemetery. Her cause of death was heart failure.³

Hattie married Frederick Dustin Gage on 23 Oct 1887 in Yarmouth; Rev. W. E. Kugler officiated⁴. Frederick was born 3 Nov 1864 in Yarmouth⁵, the son of Isaiah Gage(?)* & Lucy Jane (Marchant) Gage. He died 23 Oct 1936 in Yarmouth⁶ and is buried in Ancient Cemetery.

*Mrs. Hattie B. Gage, wife of Frederick D. Gage, was found dead early Sunday morning. Death was due to heart failure, Mrs. Gage was well known in the village and had many friends. She was a native of Yarmouth, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Jeremiah Robinson, and was 63 years of age. The funeral was held in the Union Congregational Church on Tuesday, Rev. Arthur S. Burrill officiating, and was very largely attended. Interment was in the Ancient Cemetery in Yarmouth.*⁷

*Frederick D. Gage was born almost 6 months before his mother's marriage to Isaiah Gage. His birth record in Yarmouth town records first says MARCHANT, then is crossed out and Gage is written above it. Isaiah's name is penciled in, clearly later, as the father. It is quite likely that Isaiah was not the father. Isaiah and Lucy separated after Frederick's birth and Lucy remarried a few years later.
